Citizen's Police Academy

The Hampton Police Division is currently accepting applications for the Citizen's Police Academy. The academy begins February 8th and extends through May 2nd. Classes will be held each Monday from 5:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m., for a period of thirteen weeks. The participants will have an opportunity to meet with Chief Terry Sult, police executives, veteran officers, civilians and volunteers. The curriculum will include a variety of subjects pertaining to law enforcement and public safety.

The Citizen's Police Academy is an excellent way to partner with the Hampton Police Division. Applications for the Citizen's Police Academy can be obtained by calling the Hampton Police Division's Community Engagement Unit at (757)727-6574. Applicants must live or work in the City of Hampton and submit applications by January 29, 2016.

The Citizen's Police Academy is designed to educate Hampton residents about how the Hampton Police Division achieves its' goal of preventing crime and enforcing laws through problem solving partnerships. Each applicant is required to pass a criminal background check conducted by the Hampton Police Division and class size is limited to a maximum of 20 per class.
