Deceased Identified in Pedestrian Crash: 900 Block of North King Street

The Hampton Police Division has identified the deceased pedestrian involved in the fatality that occurred on January 16, 2015.

At 8:58 p.m., Hampton Police Officers responded to a vehicle crash involving a pedestrian in the 900 block of North King Street. Upon arrival, they located an adult male that was pronounced deceased at the scene. He has been identified as **Jamar Lee Mitchner**, a 26-year-old Hampton man. They also located a second adult male, whom would later be identified as the driver whom was suffering from critical injuries. He was transported to a local hospital for treatment and is currently in stable condition.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that the pedestrian was crossing North King Street when he was struck by a 2012 Harley Davidson motorcycle that was traveling southbound on North King Street. After initially striking the pedestrian, the motorcycle continued approximately 100 yards before coming to a rest. The crash is being investigated by the members of the Hampton Police Division Reconstruction Team and remains under investigation. As additional information becomes available it will be released.
