Shooting Investigation: 1600 Block of East Pembroke Avenue

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect(s) responsible for a shooting and that occurred on April 13, 2015.

At 7:35 p.m., Public Safety Communications received several complaints of shooting in the 500 block of Smiley Road. When officer's arrived on scene, they discovered that an adult Hampton woman was had been shot while inside a residence. She was transported by members of the Hampton Fire and Rescue Division to a local hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries. At 7:54 p.m., an adult male arrived at the Sentara Careplex suffering from mulitple gun shot wounds. That individual is currently being treated for what appears to be life threatening injuries. Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears that this individual was also shot during this incident.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that two vehicles, a dark colored sedan and a gold colored sedan, exchanged gun fire in the 1600 block of East Pembroke Avenue. During the incident, both victims were shot. The investigation is on-going. Additional information will be released as the investigation continues.
