Library offers eAudiobooks starting Oct. 1

Sept. 30, 2015 – The Hampton Public Library system began offering eAudiobooks on OneClickDigital starting Thursday, Oct. 1.

Patrons of the four city libraries (Main, Northampton, Phoebus, and Willow Oaks) will have access to downloadable audiobooks from classics to current bestsellers. The collection will continue to increase in size from its current list of 4,000 titles. The eAudiobooks are compatible with multiple devices, including personal computers, cell phones and tablets. Other online services provided by the library include:

- OverDrive, which provides eBooks compatible with all popular devices.
- Pronunciator, a provider of high-quality interactive language learning courses with 80 languages available.
- Zinio, a Recorded Books product that provides access to popular magazines online (offered with the support of the Library of Virginia).

Many titles offer concurrent usage so multiple users can check out a given title simultaneously, eliminating wait times. OneClickDigital is compatible with all popular devices. Mobile apps are available in the Apple and Android app stores. The apps boast a user-friendly interface with streamlined navigation and automatic software updates.
