## Commercial Burglaries Investigations

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect(s) in connection with multiple commercial burglaries.

Between August 4, 2015 and October 5, 2015, multiple Hampton nail salon businesses have experienced commercial burglaries. The preliminary investigation revealed that after business hours, unknown suspect(s) gained access to the businesses by forcing entry through a door. Once inside, the suspect(s) removed flat screen televisions, assorted tools, and US currency.
