Shooting Investigation: 800 Block of LaSalle Avenue

The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspects in connection with a shooting that occurred on October 10, 2015.

At 11:11 p.m., Public Safety Communications received a complaint in reference to shots fired in the 800 block of LaSalle Avenue. Officers arrived on scene and located the victim, a 20-year-old Hampton man, suffering from a single gunshot wound. He was transported to a local hospital and treated for non-life threatening injuries.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that the victim was walking in the area of the 800 block of LaSalle Avenue when he was approached by a dark-colored SUV that was occupied by two suspects. One of the suspects displayed a firearm and shot at the victim multiple times, striking him once. The suspects then fled the scene northbound on LaSalle Avenue. There are no suspect descriptions to disseminate.
