REGISTRATION:

Held at the Athletic Office August 5 – August 30, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

ENTRY FEE

For the 2019 Fall League is **\$300.00 (made payable to: City of Hampton)** per team.

***A separate payment (made payable to: Jim Finch) of \$25.00 for the NSA Sanction fee** is due no later than the manager's meeting for all teams that **didn't play in the Spring 2019 Season.**

All leagues will play double headers for the regular season. Each league will play one night a week unless makeup games are scheduled. Games will be 55 mins. The top 4 teams in each league will play a single elimination tournament.

EQUIPMENT:

Women will use an 11" optic (**yellow**) softball with a maximum C.O.R. of .52. Men will use a 12" optic (**yellow**) softball with a maximum C.O.R. of .52. **Maximum Compression is 275 pounds.** Co-ed will use both a 12" and an 11" ball for male and female players respectively. All balls must have the NSA stamp. All bats must have the 2012 NSA stamp.
