

HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION: 500 BLOCK OF CORAL COURT

The Newport News Police Department needs your help in solving a past homicide.

On May 14th, 2018 at 1:13 a.m., Newport News Police were dispatched to the 500 block of Coral Court in reference to a nature unknown. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a male inside a vehicle suffering from a gunshot wound. The call was immediately upgraded to a shooting and medics responded to the scene. The male, later identified as then 23-year-old Derrius Franklin

of Fayetteville, North Carolina, was pronounced deceased at the scene. The investigation remains ongoing.

HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION: 2600 BLOCK OF CUNNINGHAM DRIVE



The Hampton Police Division is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect in connection with a business robbery that occurred on April 19, 2020.

At approximately 5:32 a.m., Hampton Police Communications received a call of a robbery that had just occurred at the 7-Eleven convenience store located in the 2600 block of Cunningham Drive. The investigation revealed the suspect entered the business, implied a firearm, and demanded money. After receiving an

undisclosed amount of U.S. currency, the suspect fled in a dark-colored small-frame pickup truck.

The suspect is described as a black male in his early 50's with a grey beard, grey hair, 5'8"-5'10", wearing a gray sweatshirt, and black and white shoes.
