ABOUT HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Habitat for Humanity Peninsula & Greater Williamsburg is a nonprofit organization which builds and sells decent, affordable houses and repairs homes for qualified, low-income homeowners. Habitat for Humanity will be providing volunteers and support to the Hampton Home Repair Blitz.

ABOUT THE HAMPTON HOME REPAIR BLITZ

The Hampton Home Repair Blitz is a partnership between the City of Hampton's Neighborhood Commission and Habitat for Humanity that serves low-income, elderly and disabled homeowners who may struggle to maintain the exterior of their homes. The Home Repair Blitz provides exterior services such as repairs to wheelchair ramps, rails, and porches, outside painting, minor siding and window repairs, safety improvements, landscaping, weatherization and outdoor clean-up.

All of the repair work will be performed for **FREE or at minimal cost** by Habitat for Humanity volunteers with materials provided through United Way donations on May 5, 2018. *Homeowners must be willing to participate by volunteering their time towards their home repairs and/or have family and friends participate on their behalf.*

HOME REPAIR BLITZ QUALIFICATIONS

1. Applicant must be a Hampton **homeowner** who is:
 - ✓ 65 years old or older
 - ✓ Disabled **OR**
 - ✓ Low-income (see chart below)
2. Applicants must **own their homes** and provide **proof of current homeowner's insurance**.
3. Applicants must live in the targeted Hampton area.
4. If qualifying based on income, use the following chart and attach **proof of income**:
